The target group in Chili-project

- project works with marginalized immigrant mothers who have no prospects in working towards integration
- the target group women are religiously or culturally constrained or simply very afraid of coming out of their homes
- women who have very little capacity of helping their children to understand Finnish culture

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Why these women?

- They are not able to understand their children's needs in new society and have unrealistic visions and traditional dreams about their future.
- Lack of contacts, language and efficiency reduces the respect from their growing children and confrontation leads to conflicts and child welfare involvement.
- FGM, forced marriages and other honour related violence matters have been possible choices in the home country.

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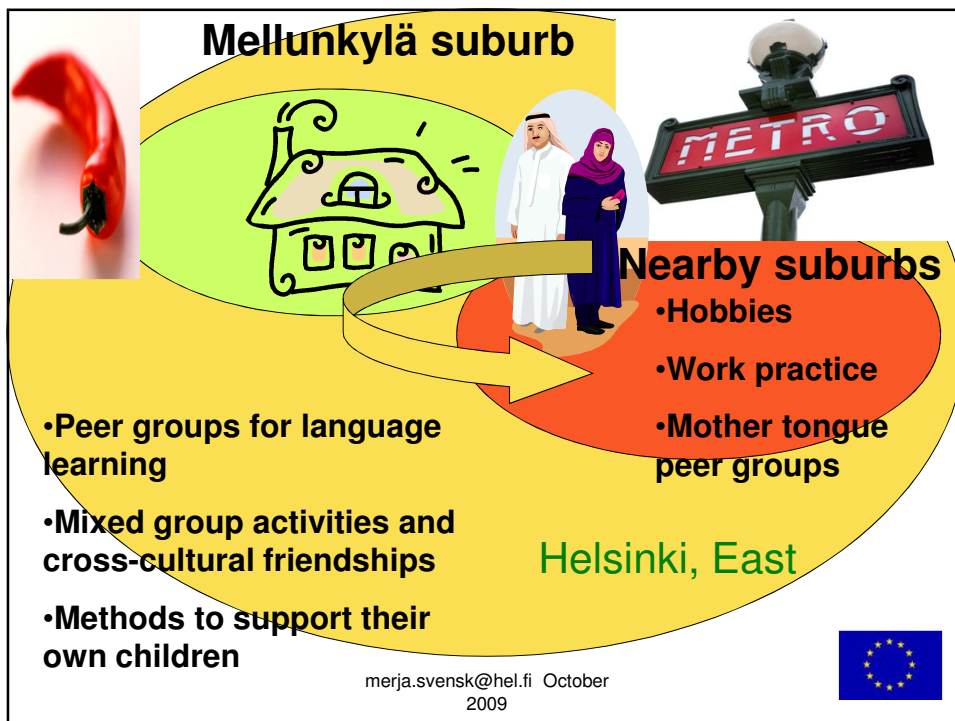


Language, information and social integration is the power

- bringing up healthy children

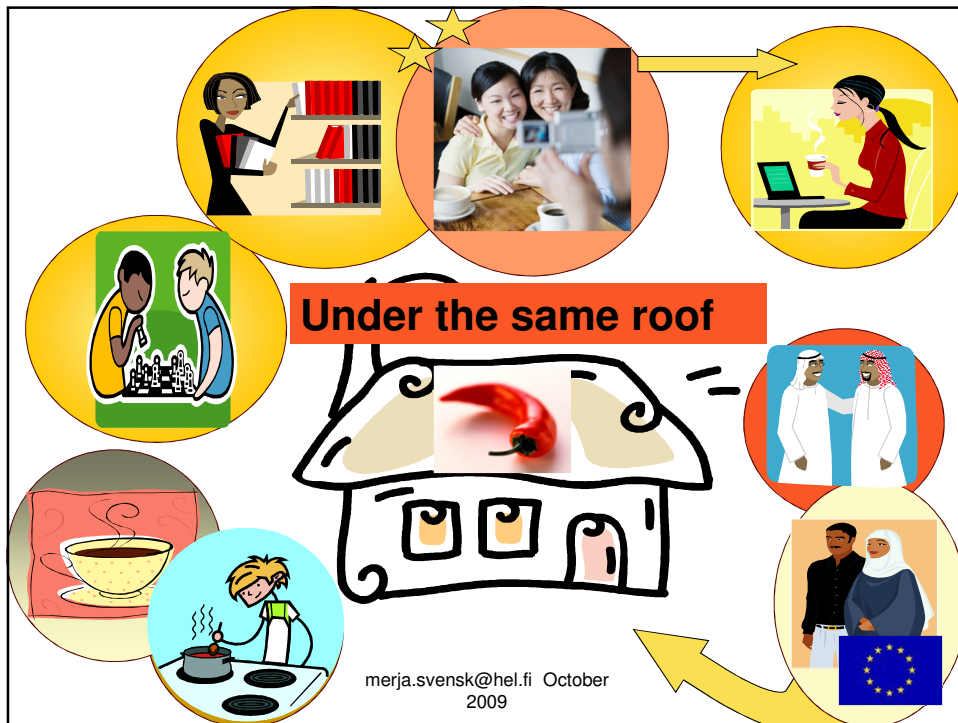
